

1. **Burn:** To gloss, brightness, luster
2. **Canvas:** A container that holds various drawing elements.
3. **Clipboard:** A place where cut or copied text is stored so that it can be copied into a document in the future.
4. **Clone:** To make an identical copy of.
5. **Constraint:** A limitation or restriction.
6. **Crop:** To cut unwanted areas from a picture.
7. **Cut:** A command in Word that removes selected text from the original location and place the deleted text in the Clipboard collection.
8. **Dodge:** To lighten a part or the whole of an image.
9. **Exposure:** Is a state in a computing system or set of systems.
10. **Filter:** A feature that allows you to look at only the data that you need.
11. **Heal:** Referring to a network or sub network that has the ability to sense, diagnose, isolate, and at least temporarily correct a fault.
12. **Image:** Drawings or illustrations, often symbolic
13. **Lasso:** The tool in an image editor program that selects complex or freehand shapes
14. **Layer:** A section within an image that can be manipulated independently.
15. **Mask:** A window like device used to isolate details of print, such as initial letters, endings, chunks or a whole word.
16. **Paste:** To insert a piece of text or other data copied from somewhere else.
17. **Pixel:** The smallest discrete component of an image or picture on a CRT screen.
18. **Resize:** To change the size of an image.
19. **Resolution:** The quality of an image.
20. **Vignette:** A small illustration or portrait photograph that fades into its background without a definite border.
