## Euphemisms

Definition  $\sim$  a mild or indirect word or expression substituted for one considered to be too harsh or blunt when referring to something unpleasant or embarrassing

## Examples:

- 1) passed away  $\rightarrow$  dead
- 2) departed  $\rightarrow$  died
- 3) let  $go \rightarrow fired$
- 4) correctional facility → jail
- 5) vertically challenged → short
- 6) in between jobs → unemployed
- 7) on the streets  $\rightarrow$  homeless
- 8) collateral damage → accidental deaths
- 9) becoming a little thin on top  $\rightarrow$  bald
- 10) economically challenged→ poor
- 11) bun in the oven  $\rightarrow$  pregnant
- 12) reduced circumstances → bankrupt
- 13) under the weather  $\rightarrow$  sick
- 14) enhanced interrogation → torture
- 15) unmotivated  $\rightarrow$  lazy

## Sentences:

- 1) Sarah was economically challenged.
- Sarah was not doing well with money.
- 2) Bob was let off.
- Bob was fired from his job.

## Skit:

Allie- laying on floor Clara: Look, she's dead. Sami: No, she passed away.

Allie: Sami, you've been let go.

Sami: I was just let go. Clara: No, you were fired.

Clara: Allie, you're so short.

Sami: No, she's just vertically challenged.
