Euphemism

Euphemism- a mild or indirect word or expression substituted for one considered to be too harsh or blunt when referring to something unpleasant or embarrassing (n.)

Examples:

- 1. Heather was sent to the **funny farm**. (Heather went to the insane asylum.)
- 2. She passed away. (She died.)
- 3. We have to **let you go**. (They had to fire someone.)
- 4. She had a **pregnancy termination.** (She got an abortion.)
- 5. She is **big-boned**. (She was overweight.)
- 6. She watched **adult entertainment**. (She watched pornography.)
- 7. She has some **extra curves**. (She's fat.)
- 8. He had too many **adult beverages**. (He's drunk.)
- 9. They put their dog **to sleep**. (They killed him.)
- 10. The lady was **chronologically-challenged**. (She's always late.)
- 11. He **lives on the streets**. (He's homeless.)
- 12. She was sent to a **correctional facility**. (She went to jail.)
- 13. He was a **sanitation engineer**. (He was a garbage man.)
- 14. He's getting **over the hill.** (He's getting old.)
- 15. The girl had always been **economical with the truth**. (She was a liar.)
- 16. The lady was **vertically-challenged**. (She was short.)
- 17. She went to **powder her nose**. (She went to the restroom.)
